# Way, Truth, and Life (Jn14)

## 1 The House (1,1 2)

Where I am going you **cannot follow** me now,  
but you will follow **afterward**.

Truly, truly, I say to you, the rooster will  
not crow till you have **denied me** three times.

John 13:36,38 (ESV)

Let not your hearts be **troubled**.  
Believe in God; **believe** also in me.

John 14:1 (ESV)

In my Father's **house** are many rooms.  
If it were not so, would I have told you  
that I go to **prepare** a place for you?

And if I go and prepare a place for you,  
I will **come again** and will take you to myself,  
that **where I am** you may be also.

John 14:2-3 (ESV)

For this light **momentary affliction**  
is preparing for us an eternal  
**weight of glory** beyond all comparison,  
as we look not to the things that are **seen**  
but to the things that are **unseen**.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 (ESV)

Have I ever felt  
**abandoned** by Jesus?

Thomas said to him, “Lord, we do not know  
**where** you are going.

How can we know the **way**?”

John 14:4-5 (ESV)

Jesus said to him,  
“I am the **way**, and the **truth**, and the **life**.  
No one comes to the Father  
except **through me**.”

John 14:6 (ESV)

I am the **door**.  
If anyone **enters** by me,  
  
he will be **saved**  
and will go **in and out**  
and find **pasture**.

John 10:9 (ESV)

If you **abide** in my word,  
you are truly my **disciples**,  
and you will know the **truth**,  
and the truth will set you **free**.

John 8:31-32 (ESV)

Whoever **believes** in me,  
though he **die**, yet shall he **live**,

John 14:7 (ESV)

Philip said to him,

John 14:8-9 (ESV)

Whoever has seen **me** has seen the **Father**.

How can you say, '**Show us** the Father'?

Do you not believe that I am **in the Father**  
and the Father is **in me**?

John 14:9-10 (ESV)

The words that I say to you  
I do not speak on my own **authority**,  
but the **Father** who dwells in me  
does his works.

John 14:10 (ESV)

Do I still **yearn**  
to see God?
